### MVUSBC YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

#### 1. GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

- a. This tournament will be conducted under USBC tournament rules. Printed rule books are available upon request . Rules & reference are also available online at **bowlingrulebook.com**.
- b. Youth participants must be active members of the MVUSBC YOUTH ASSOCIATION. Any adult may participate, even if they are not USBC certified members prior to the tournament. The Tournament Director will register any uncertified adults for the purpose of this tournament only and will cover the \$ 5:00 participation fee required by USBC.
- c. HANDICAP FOR THE TOURNAMENT IS 85% OF THE DIFFERENCE FROM 500 FOR THE TEAM.
- d. MULTIPLE ENTRIES ARE ALLOWED WITH A CHANGE OF PARTNER.
- e. RE-ENTRY AND WALK-INS are allowed, based upon availability, with an additional \$ 2.00 donation.
- f. The prize fund will be used for trophies. The remaining funds will be used for scholarship awards with a ratio of 1 to 10 (1 scholarship for every 10 entries) used and remaining funds returned 100 %.
- g. The MVUSBC YOUTH portion of the entry fee will be used to fund the annual MVUSBC YOUTH scholarship.
- h. The closing date for all prepaid entries is February 25, 2007. All prepaid applications must be submitted by this date. Incomplete or unpaid entries will be treated as walk-ins (see rule 1e above).

CHECK OR MONEY ORDERS ONLY – NO CASH – NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON

#### 2. DIVISIONS:

THERE WILL BE FOUR (4) DIVISIONS AS FOLLOWS: A=ADULT, Y=YOUTH, M=MALE, F=FEMALE (1) AF/YF (2) AF/YM (3) AM/YF (4) AM/YM

#### 3. AVERAGES:

- a. The youth bowler must have a USBC certified average for the current season consisting of at least 21 games.
- b. The adult bowler will use their highest USBC certified average consisting of 21 games or more for the current season. If no average for the current season, last years highest USBC certified average consisting of 21 or more games will be used. If the adult is not USBC certified and bowled in this tournament last year, their average from last years tournament will Be used.
- c. A copy of the youth league standing sheet containing averages for games bowled by February 18, 2007, must be submitted to the Tournament Director for verification by the prepaid entry closing date (February 25, 2007).
- d. This is a youth tournament, so in respect to reporting correct averages, rule 319A.3 will be enforced.

#### 4. TARDY OR ABSENT BOWLERS:

- a. Tardy bowlers must begin in the frame being bowled at the time of arrival. Previous frames get a score of zero.
- b. In the event that a bowler cannot finish a game in progress due to legitimate complications, 10 % of their average is to be used as the score for each unfinished frame in the game.
- c. In special circumstances, The Tournament Director may allow a blind score of 90 % of the bowlers average to be used after reviewing the details of the circumstance (e.g. emergency during tournament).
- d. All changes must be requested at least 30 minutes prior to squad time and require review for approval.

#### 5. IMPORTANT NOTES FOR COACHES, PARENTS & BOWLERS:

- a. Coaches will be notified of the official squad assignments (date & time) for their bowlers.
- b. No food or drink is allowed in the bowling area. Alcoholic beverages are to be restricted to the bar areas.
- c. NO FORM OF COACHING IS ALLOWED DURING TOURNAMENT COMPETITION.
- d. Winners will be officially notified and awards distributed by their youth coach.
- f. Tentative and official results will be posted on **mvusbcyouth.tripod.com** as soon as possible.
